## **There is' and 'There are' STRUCTURE.**

**We use 'there is' and 'there are' to say that something exists.**

**Singular(Ενικός): there is**

**Plural(Πληθυντικός) : there are**

**There is a tree in the yard.**

**There are two cats on the chair.**

**Contraction (Συναίρεση):**

**There is a tree. = There's a tree. ~You cannot contract 'There are'**

**Negative (ΑΡΝΗΣΗ): There is not a tree in the yard. There are not two cats on the chair.**

**Negative Contraction: There's not a tree in the yard. There aren't two cats on the chair. There isn't a tree in the yard.**

**Question (ΕΡΩΤΗΣΗ): Is there a tree in the yard? Are there two cats on the chair?**
